

# Insulation Displacement Connectors

IDC (Insulation Displacement Connector) connectors, also known as IPC (insulation-piercing contact), are commonly used in electronics and telecommunications applications where a large number of wires need to be connected quickly and efficiently. These connectors work by using sharp teeth or blades to pierce the insulation of the flat cable, making contact with the conductors inside. This creates a secure and reliable electrical connection between the cable and the connector.
