The BNC connector (initialism for "Bayonet Neill-Concelman") is a miniature quick connect/disconnect radio frequency connector used for coaxial cable. Commonly used in radio, television, and other radio-frequency electronic equipment, more so for the early computer networks, including ARCnet, the IBM PC Network, and the 10BASE2 variant of Ethernet.
